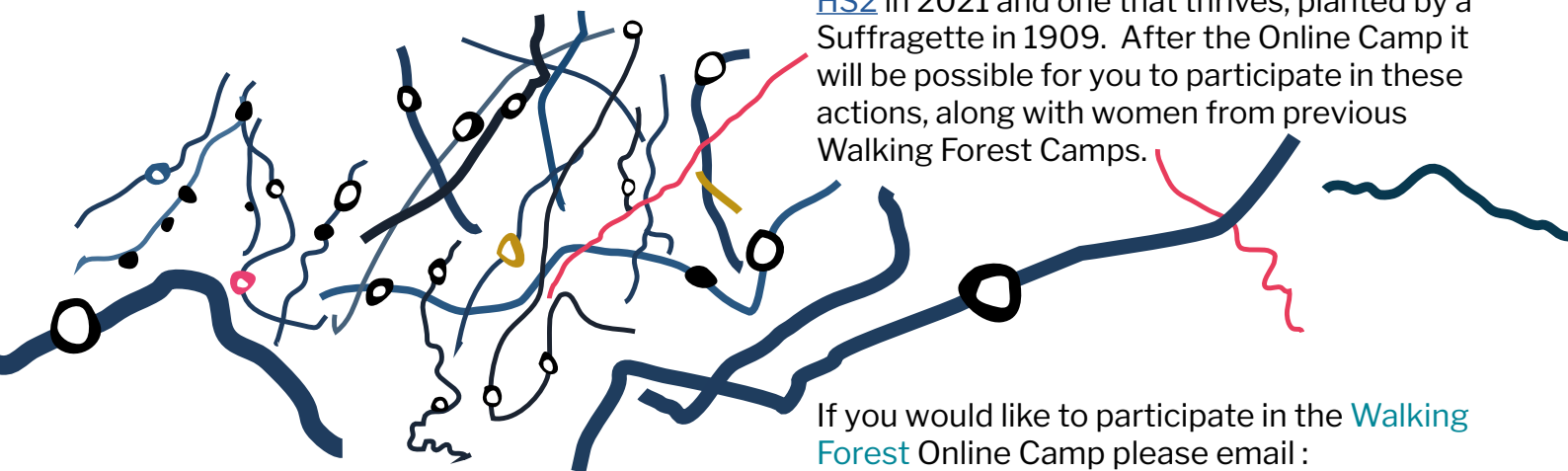


An invitation to join the **WALKING FOREST** Online Glasgow Camp

Are you a woman inspired by the natural world, hoping to make change in your community and the wider world?

Are you concerned about climate change and social injustice?

Would you like to learn more about shaping creative responses and actions in response to these issues?

Would you like to understand more about the COP26 Climate Talks in Glasgow in November?

We'd love to meet you if so. We are Anne-Marie, Lucy, Ruth and Shelley, a group of artists working on a 10 year artwork called [Walking Forest](#) linking women, trees and activism.

We are hosting this Online Camp in association with Glasgow School of Art and After The Pandemic for people who identify as women age 18+. You'll be part of an intergenerational group of primarily Glasgow women connecting local and global issues, exploring ways of living that are grounded in care, respect, co-operation and action.

We will be sharing stories of standing up for change, learning about forest ecology, exploring the role of craft in activism, learning about Ecocide and our Earth's Rights and the links between social and environmental justice. We will be hearing from women acting as Earth Defenders around the world and about what could happen during COP26 (Council of the Parties).

In November, during COP26 we will be carrying out a number of [Walking Forest](#) Performance Actions inspired by two trees: one felled by [HS2](#) in 2021 and one that thrives, planted by a Suffragette in 1909. After the Online Camp it will be possible for you to participate in these actions, along with women from previous Walking Forest Camps.
